- ✓ Minimum 33% of FPC shareholders (numbers) should be small, marginal, landless or tenant farmers.
- ✓ Min one lady director
- **✓** Full time CEO
- ✓ Minimum Rs.5 lacs equity
- ✓ In operation for at least 2 years
- ✓ No accumulated losses in previous years
- ✓ Preference to FPCs having **complete value chain** and assured forward linkage for sale of produce
